As part of the combined solution, Hispasat provides satellite capacity in Ku band over Latin America and Europe from its 30°W and 61°W orbital positions.

The combined offer includes the terminal and connectivity in a single service with a monthly fee, which eliminates one of the main entry barriers by saving the customer the investment in the equipment. In addition, it is a flexible and scalable business model in which you can hire a plan with a minimum capacity and increase it when necessary.
